Faculty and staff are busy preparing for our transition to remote/online learning. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through these unprecedented times. Below is an outline of our plan to transition to remote/online learning. More information will be coming from classroom teachers in the upcoming days as we continue to work in this fluid situation.

Preschool

We will be sending a preschool learning package, which will contain lesson plans. Each night we will be communicating with you to review the task in the packet for the following day by email and answering questions or giving further instructions. The daily lessons may include a variety of the following:

- Hands on activities
- Dramatic play instructions
- On-line resources
- Workbook (handwriting Our Catholic Faith)
- Manipulates

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

Daily school work will be posted on Google Classroom by 10:00 PM the night before. The post for the day will include any necessary instructions for the lesson. In addition to work we have sent home already, we will be utilizing a variety of apps and online components. You and your child can communicate to us through Google Classroom and/or email.

- Daily login on Google Classroom (used for attendance)
- Daily assignments on Google Classroom
- Completion of work as assigned
- Compliance with the Technology Usage Policy

3rd & 4th Grade

Daily school work will be posted on Google Classroom by 10:00pm the night before. The post for the day will include any necessary notes and materials for the lesson. Students will be able to use their Good Shepherd email to communicate with their teacher.

- Daily login to Google Classroom by 9:00am to be used for attendance
- Completion of daily work as assigned
- Compliance with the Technology Usage Policy

5th & 6th Grade

Daily work will be posted on Google Classroom by 9am each day. The post for the day will include any necessary notes and materials for the lesson. Teachers will be checking emails and responding to questions between 9:00-11:30am and then again from 1pm-3pm.

- Students must check their teachers homeroom attendance post on Google Classroom by 9am
- Submission of work should be done upon completion or by 9am on the due date
- Compliance with Technology Usage Policy
- Assessments may need to be given at some point during e-learning

Specialists

Specialists have set up Google classrooms for each class or grade level for their subject area. They will communicate and post assignments in this Google Classroom. Assignments will be posted on Sundays by 5:00 pm for the upcoming week. Students may post questions and receive feedback through Google classroom. More information on how to access Google Classroom will come through the classroom teachers.
