

Good Shepherd Catholic School Laptop Parent Agreement

A MacBook is being loaned to your child by Good Shepherd to expand and personalize his/her learning opportunities this year. It is essential that the Laptop Student Agreement, the Acceptable Use Policy, and the other laptop program policies be followed by your student to ensure the safe, efficient, and ethical operation of Good Shepherd's computer. In order for your child to use the MacBook in class and to take it home, you must accept the following terms and responsibilities:

- I have read the Acceptable Use Policy, the Laptop Student Agreement, the Laptop Student Handbook, and the technology policies found in the Good Shepherd Parent/Student Handbook. I also have discussed these documents with my child.
- I will supervise my child's use of the MacBook at home. I will discuss appropriate use of the Internet, will supervise my child's use of the Internet, and will not rely solely on the *Parental Controls* preferences applied to the MacBook. I understand that my child should not use the MacBook to visit social networking or gaming sites, such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Fortnite, Musically etc....
- I understand that the MacBook is being provided to my child for educational purposes and that the MacBook should not be used by parents or other family members.
- I will remind my child, as necessary, to charge the MacBook nightly and to bring it to school each day with a fully charged battery. I will have my child use a surge protector when charging the MacBook.
- The MacBook will be kept in the Always On MacBook Case at all times. I understand that I am responsible for replacing any case which I or Good Shepherd deem to be damaged and insufficient protection for the MacBook.
- Away from school, I will ensure that the MacBook is used in a location free from food, liquid, and debris and provides a flat surface on which to operate it.
- Recognizing that I am the best judge of whether my child can responsibly/safely use the MacBook away from home, I understand that Good Shepherd has not banned students from traveling with the MacBook or from using it in locations other than home/school. I further understand that my child may not travel with or use the MacBook away from home/school other than with my permission and that I am responsible for damage/loss that may occur.
- I understand that the MacBook may be inspected by Good Shepherd staff upon request and that the MacBook and its contents (whether created at home or at school) can be viewed by Good Shepherd staff when my child is signed on to the Good Shepherd network. I understand my child should not delete the browser history, cache, or cookies from the MacBook and will be held responsible for any inappropriate use of the MacBook at home or at school in accordance with the Good Shepherd's Code of Conduct.
- I understand that my child may not deface or decorate the MacBook or the Always On MacBook Case.
- I will not attempt to repair, alter, or make additions to the MacBook, its hardware or software.
- I understand that the MacBook and its contents are Good Shepherd's property. I will not remove any program/files on the MacBook except for the personal documents of my child.
